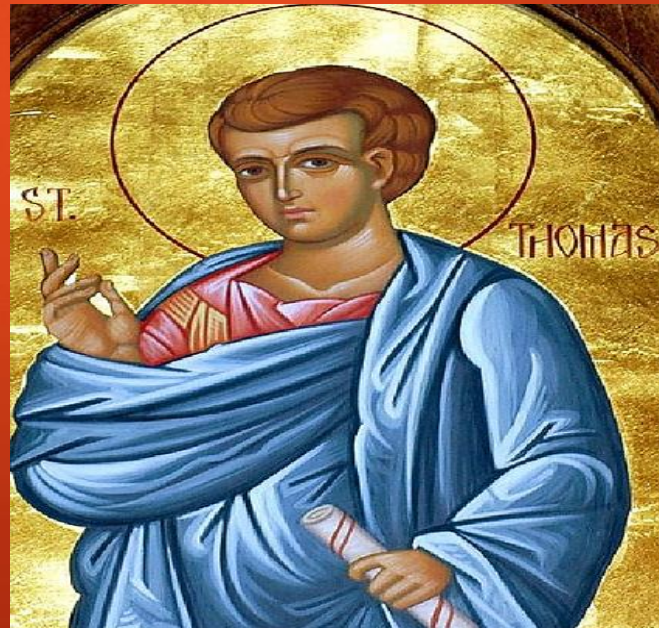
1. Which apostle was a tax collector before following Jesus?

Thomas

- ▶ Best remembered for doubting that Jesus had risen until he could touch his wounds.
- ▶ He is believed to have shared the Good News through India and Persia, where he eventually died a martyr.

Simon

- ▶ The only apostle who was a zealot.
- ▶ He preached the Gospel in Egypt & was eventually martyred.
- ▶ His symbol is a saw.

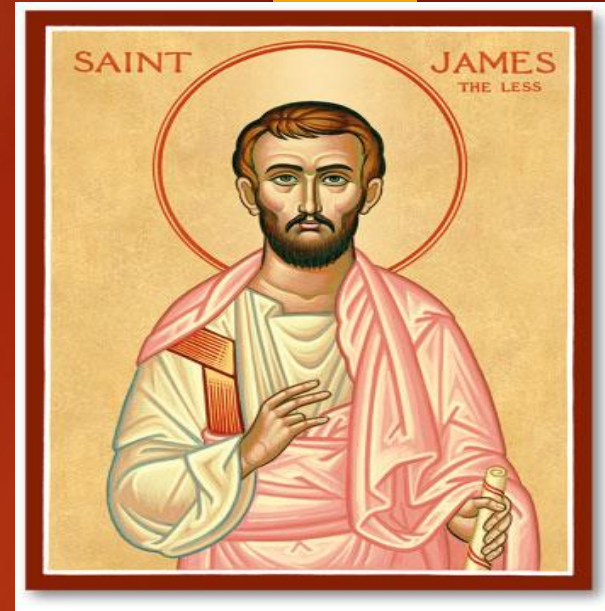


James the Less

- ▶ The brother of Jude & possibly a cousin of Jesus.
- ▶ James was the first bishop of Jerusalem.
- ▶ He was eventually martyred & his symbol is a club.

Jude

- ▶ Also known as Thaddeus.
- ▶ He has become popular as the patron of hopeless cases.
- ▶ He preached in Persia & one of the letters in the NT bears his name.
- ▶ His symbol is an axe.



Judas



- ▶ Based on his name, Judas is believed to have come from Judea.
- ▶ He was entrusted with the care of the common funds & helped himself to some of the money.
- ▶ He betrayed Jesus for 30 pieces of silver (coins are his symbol)
- ▶ When he realized what he'd done, he didn't return to Jesus for forgiveness (like Peter)
- ▶ Instead, Judas committed suicide. In the Acts, Judas fell & died in a field he bought with his silver.
